

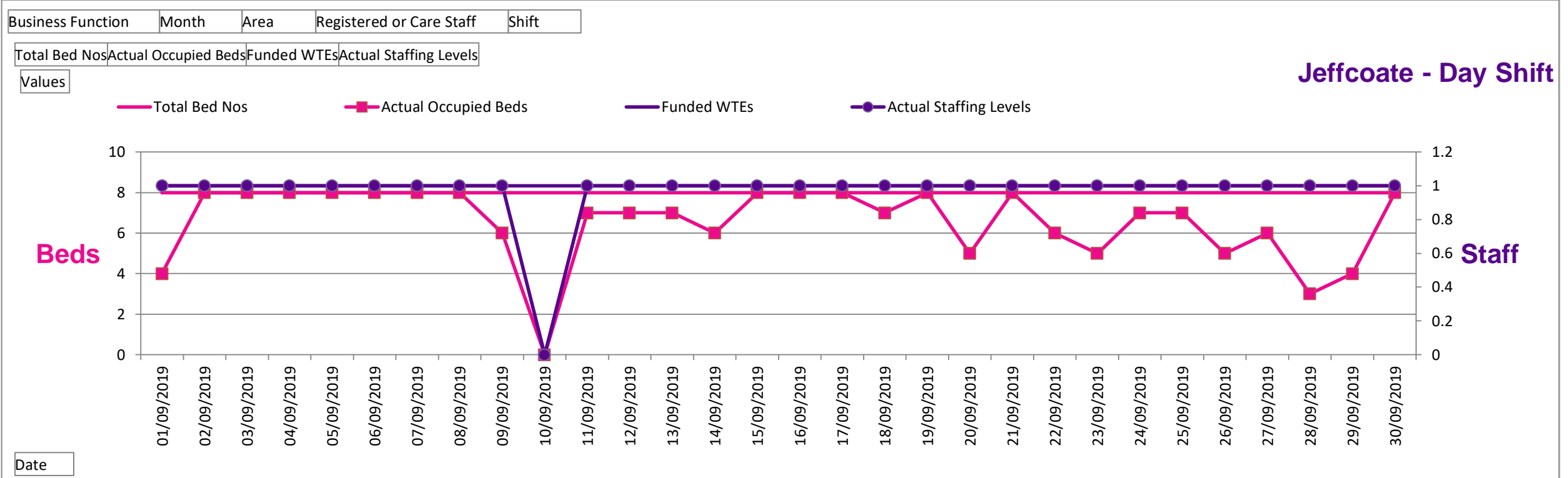

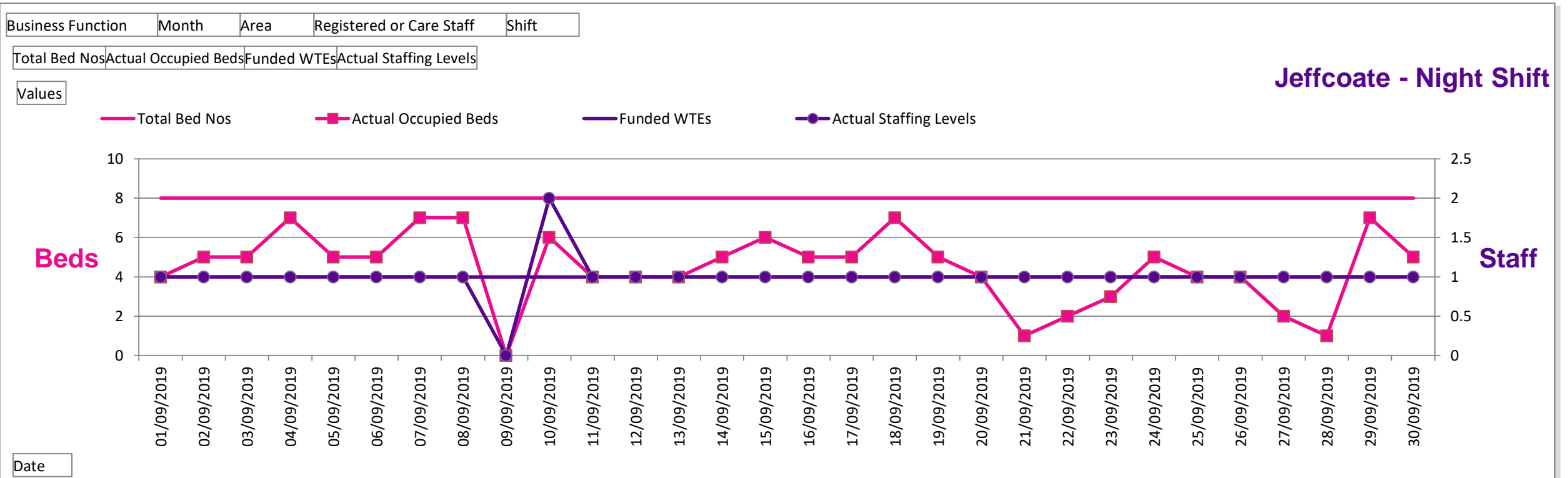
Day Shift
