




Staffing Report - Gynaecology February 2020 Last updated: 17/03/2020 at 15:27





There has been a reduction in staff Numbers due to short tem sickness and current vacancy, furthermore the bed occupancy has exceeded the maximum of 24 inpatient capacity on two occasions.

Matron Assurance Statement

Febuary has seen increased unfilled duties due to current vacancy rate with 6 vacancies requiring recruitment. Three newly recruited nurses have a start date during March 2020 with a further two more estimated in April subject to reference check and ocupational clearance. All vacancies registered on TRAC and shortlisted for interview in a timely manner. To cover Vacancies and some short term sickness current staff have been offered bank shifts and if required the use of agency Nurses has been requested. Long term sick registered Nurse has returned to work however has required a phased return with suuport to ensure practice is at the level it should be, this again whilst necessary and supported by HR is a further staffing pressure for the ward at present. Ward bed occupancy has been reviewed and new process for allocating inpatient beds and escalation if a bed is needed which is above the 24 inpatient remit, ward sisters informed and evidentry paperwork inplace
